



Biosecurity for Equine Events

You can help ensure the health and well-being of your horse, others' horses and the future of this event by following these simple equine biosecurity rules:

- 1** Limit horse-to-horse contact, especially nose-to-nose contact.
- 2** Monitor your horse for clinical signs of disease.
- 3** Report a temperature over 102°F to a show veterinarian.
- 4** Avoid communal water sources and sharing equipment without disinfecting and cleaning.
- 5** Limit horse-to-human-to-horse contact, when possible.
