**REQUESTED ACTION:**

At the March 4, 2021, Board meeting, the Department will request approval of a preliminary hearing and comment period for the attached scope statement, regarding ch. ATCP 160 relating to fair organizations.

**SUMMARY:**

The objective of the proposed rule is to repeal or modify an obsolete or unnecessary rule. Section ATCP 160.92 (6) requires a copy of the fair organization's annual financial report as published in the newspaper to be submitted to the department. 2015 Wisconsin Act 207 repealed the requirement that a fair organization publish a financial report as a class I notice in the newspaper. Therefore, this subsection is obsolete.

The Department anticipates that the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules will direct DATCP to hold a preliminary public hearing and comment period, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.136 (1).
