### 1.2 KEY POINTS RELATED TO SWRM GRANTS

- Email reimbursement requests to [datcpswrm@wisconsin.gov](mailto:datcpswrm@wisconsin.gov)
  
- Refer to Section 2.2 of the SWRM website, [Cost Share Funding Source Table and NR151 Code](#) to identify the correct unit of measurement for each ATCP 50 practice. If the number of units has changed from the cost share contract include the correct units in the email when submitting the reimbursement request. This reference document will also aid in identifying the correct NR151 code and associated cost-share rates.
  
- Other allowable uses for SEG cost-share funds:
  - Without prior approval by DATCP, a county may use up to 50 percent of the county’s SEG cost-share allocation on the following practices to implement a NM plan:
    - 50.67, Contour farming
    - 50.68, Cover crop
    - 50.82, Residue management
    - 50.89, StripcroppingA nutrient management plan checklist must be submitted with the reimbursement request.
  
  - With preapproval from DATCP, a county may use 50 percent of their SEG cost-share funds on select practices including grassed waterways, manure storage, and other bondable practices related to NM plan implementation. A completed NM checklist is required with the reimbursement request. Email DATCP for approval to use SEG funds on a bondable practice prior to signing the cost-share contract with the landowner.
  
- In 2024 the funding source for SWRM cost-share traditionally referred to as “bond” funds will be coming from general purpose revenue (GPR) funds. Bond or GPR funded cost-share projects will be referred to as “structural” practices.
