







Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Pesticide Certification





Commercial UAV Applicator

-  Get the proper FAA Credentialing
-  Get certified in a base category
i.e) 1.1 Field and Vegetable
-  Get certified in 9.9 Aerial Application.
-  Once certified, apply for an annual Individual Commercial Applicators License.
-  Have a Pesticide Business License

Private UAV Applicator

-  Proper FAA Credentialing
-  Certified in a base category
i.e) 100 General Farming
-  Certified in 111.0 Aerial Application
-  ***If you are a private applicator and you do NOT apply Restricted Use Pesticides via UAV, then certification is NOT necessary.***

REMEMBER:

-  Large UAV's (more than 55 lbs.) have additional FAA regulations compared to small UAV's (less than 55lbs.)
-  You must follow the label of the product you are using and make sure it does not prohibit aerial applications
